2022 Impact Report

With your support we were able to provide shelter and services to 113 families experiencing homelessness in Allegheny County

These households included 116 adults and 193 children who were provided with case worker services, parenting and financial skills classes, after-school program assistance, access to our on-site pantry, and ongoing support from our caseworkers after they secured permanent housing.

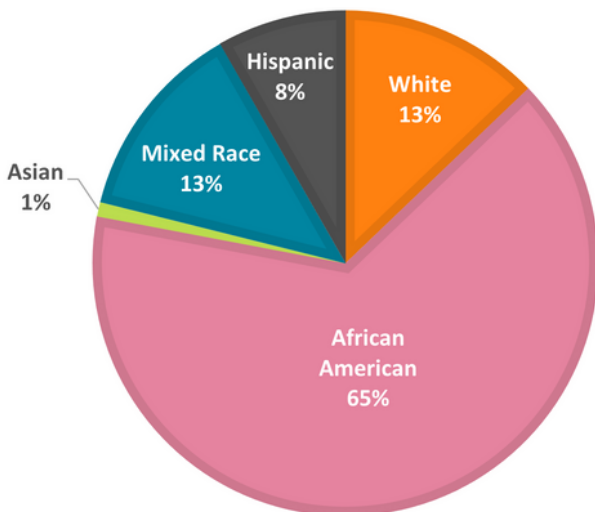
